

## **Player Registration Guidelines** (Updated January 2012)

### **Registering A Player Who Has Not Played For Another Club**

- All players registering to play in the Y&DSCL for the first time must be registered via play-cricket prior to them playing. You do not have to submit a paper registration form.
- Play-cricket will not allow you to enter the name of an un-registered player. If you have called up a player as a last minute replacement, he or she must be registered via play-cricket within 48 hours of the match taking place.

### **Registering A Player You Are Transferring From Another Club**

- All players joining your club from another club must be registered via play-cricket, and you must also submit a completed transfer form (RF7) to the League Registration Secretary.
- This form must arrive at least 48 hours prior to the player making a League appearance.

### **Registering A Player Under The Open Age Player Loan Scheme**

- Players wishing to play for another Y&DSCL club under the open age player loan scheme may only do so once a temporary transfer form (RF8) has been accepted by the League.
- Any such player's 'registration' will be moved between clubs only by League Officials.
- Open age loans are only permitted between Y&DSCL & Conference clubs.

### **Registering A Player Under The Junior Loan Scheme**

- All players joining our club under the junior loan scheme must be registered via play-cricket, and you must also submit a completed temporary transfer form (RF4). This should be sent to the Registration Secretary prior to the player making a League appearance.

### **Recreational Overseas Players**

- All applications for the registration of an ROP will be considered the League's Registration Panel. Contact the League Registration Secretary in the first instance.
